- In my role as a Frontend Developer with the Educated team, I had the pleasure of laying the groundwork for a project from scratch along with the rest of the teams.
- Being part of a startup, I took the opportunity to work on as many frontend-related tasks as possible. I participated in discussions about the website's design and subsequently carried out their implementation.
- My main duties in this position were the implementation and adjustment of the design, and the creation of 'core' components for the project (modular components that could later be used throughout the project).
- In this role, the main framework used was NextJs, and I had the chance to perform the integration of various functionalities with the backend of the project.
- Besides NextJs, I also used other technologies in this position such as TypeScript, MaterialUi (MUI), and React Query (Tanstack).
- Unfortunately the collaboration was cut short as the company didn't continue the development of the platform.
